Every activity carries with it some risk. At this unprecedented moment in history, the risk of COVID-19 is everywhere. There have been many studies conducted in order to determine how the virus is spread and the risks of certain activities. Any group activity and especially activities that are indoors for prolonged periods are of particular risk. Buffalo Girlchoir is following the latest guidelines from the CDC, NYS and Erie County Departments of Health, and the International Performing Arts Aerosol Study. However, we cannot guarantee that these measures will completely eliminate the risk of contracting COVID-19.

Buffalo Girlchoir has decided to restart rehearsals in fall 2021 with safety measures in place including HEPA air filtration, mask wearing, and hand sanitizing stations at both entrances to the studios. In the spirit of community here is what we agree to do for each other:

Families will:

- Keep their daughters home if they are showing symptoms of COVID-19 which include but are not limited to fever, sore throat, and cough.
- Notify Girlchoir if any member of their family contracts COVID-19 or if singer has been in close contact with a positive case in the last 10 days
- Follow safety protocol laid out by Buffalo Girlchoir

Buffalo Girlchoir will:

- Cancel rehearsal if a director or a member of her family is showing symptoms of COVID-19
- Notify families if anyone attending rehearsals contracts COVID-19 while also maintaining singer privacy
- Maintain cleaning and safety protocols

Further, families of Buffalo Girlchoir singers assume all risks and agree to hold harmless the organization should a singer contract COVID-19 while participating in Girlchoir activities.
